Please read all instruction before beginning your blocks. You may wish to use an alternative method to the one given to complete the individual blocks.

Detailed instructions are given for rotary cutting methods and machine piecing.

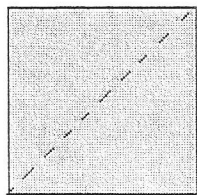
A $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance is to be used throughout.

Cutting

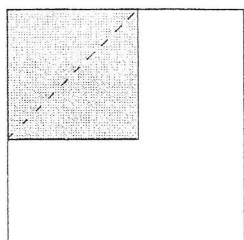
Light Scraps Cut 16 strips $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20" or equivalent.
Cut at $4\frac{1}{2}$ " intervals to create $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares - cut 64 squares.

Construction

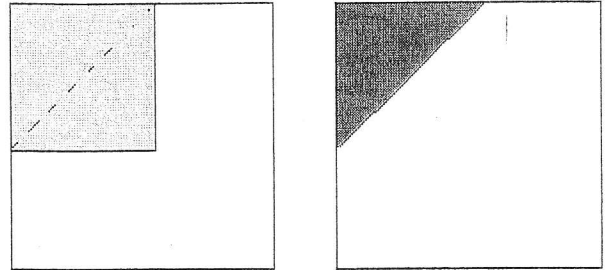
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each of the 128 dark $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares set aside in the instructions for part 1.



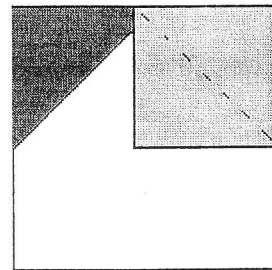
2. With right sides together place a dark square on top of one corner of a light square.
3. Sew the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dark square to the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " light square along the diagonal drawn on the dark square.



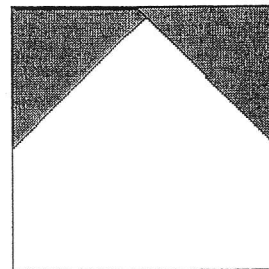
4. Trim leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " allowance and press seam allowance towards dark fabric.



5. Sew another $2\frac{1}{2}$ " dark square to an adjacent corner of the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " light square.



6. Trim and press seam allowance towards dark fabric



7. Make 64 of these units that should each measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
