## MYSTERY QUILT 2011 – 2012

### CLUE TWO

*This quilt is great if you wish to reduce your stash somewhat!*

### CONSTRUCTION

Make sure your  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance is accurate—all blocks assume an accurate  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Use background and medium coloured prints to make four-patch block.

### FOUR-PATCH BLOCKS

#### *Cutting*

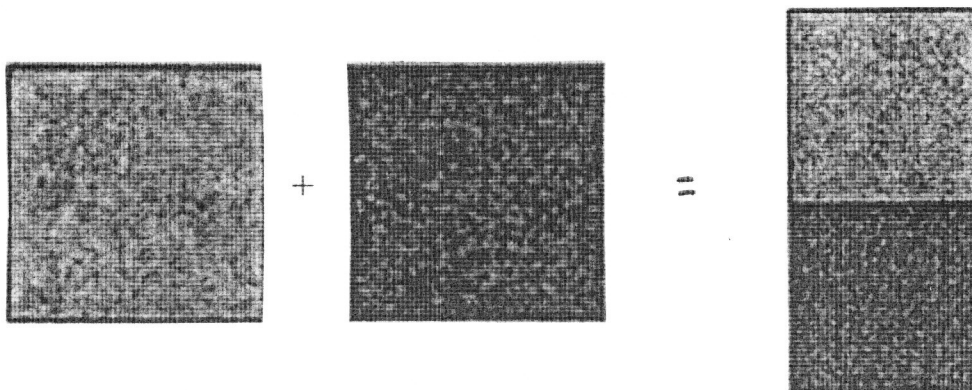
From BACKGROUND PRINTS:

- Cut 64 , 1 1/2 inch squares

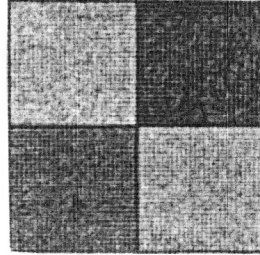
From ASSORTED MEDIUM PRINTS:

- Cut 64, 1 1/2 inch squares

1. Pair 1 background square and medium square right sides together. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$  seam. Press toward darker fabric.



2. Arrange two similar coloured segments together, and sew seam as shown. Press as shown by arrows.



Sew into Four-Patch blocks. Make 32.

3. Trim four-patch blocks to 2"x 2".
