



The block was adapted using 5" charm squares instead of 10" squares as was originally used in pattern.  
This block was taken from Missouri Star Quilt Co. BLOCK Magazine, Late Summer Vol. 1 Issue 4

Arrange blocks so that seams do not intersect.



Cut 9-patch into 4 equal blocks

Cut the 9-patch once down the center vertically; once through the center horizontally.



Cutting Block

Make 9-patch with sashing

strips between the 3 rows as you sew them together.

Lay out 9 squares in an eye-pleasing 3 x 3 configuration. Sew 5" sashing strips between the charm squares as you sew each row together. Press to the sashing. Next, add (2) 16" sashing.

To create the basic quilt block, first make a 9-patch using charm squares and adding sashing.

Basic Block

2 - 16" x 1 1/2" strips white

6 - 5" x 1 1/2" strips white

9 - 5" squares coloured

Orange, yellow, gold, coral, rust

White Fabric
