# **MYSTERY QUILT - ADQG 2022-2023**

### Part 1 - September, 2022

### Fabric Requirements and Cutting Instructions:

You will need a dark, 2 mediums, a medium light and a background fabric to make this project, as well as binding, batting and backing. We hope you will find all of these in your stash.

#### **Cutting Instructions:**

Background fabric:	Cut 4	4½" X 8½" rectangles	(A)
	Cut 36	4½" squares	(B)
Medium Light fabric:	Cut 8	4½" squares	(K)
Medium fabric #1:	Cut 4	8½" squares	(P)
	Cut 8	4½" squares	(Q)
Medium fabric #2"	Cut 12	41/2" X 81/2" rectangles	(G)
Dark fabric:	Cut 1	8½" square	(C)
	Cut 4	4½" squares	(D)

Cut all fabrics following instructions, label and store each colour in a separate baggie.

The completed quilt (before borders) should measure  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Before cutting these final border pieces, measure and cut according to your measurements.

Cut 2 2½" X 32½" strips Cut 2 2½" X 36½" strips

Use your choice of fabric for the border

## **MYSTERY QUILT - ADQG 2022-2023**

### Part 1 - September, 2022


#### Block Assembly - Part 1:

(a) Sew a background 41/2" square (B) to a dark 41/2" square (D)

Then sew to a 4 ½" X 8 ½" background rectangle (A)

Press in direction of arrows

Each unit will measure 81/2" X 81/2"




(b) Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of eight 4½" background squares (B)
With right sides facing, lay a (B) square on top of a medium #2 (G) rectangle so the drawn
line goes from left to right (see diagram)


Stitch on drawn line and trim 1/4" away from seam

Press in direction of arrows

Make 4

Each unit will measure 41/2" X 81/2"





## Page 2 - September block assembly instructions

(c) With right sides facing, lay a (B) square on the left side of a (G) rectangle so the drawn line goes from right to left (see diagram)

Stitch on drawn line and trim 1/4" away from seam

Press in direction of arrows

Make 4

Each unit will measure 41/2" X 81/2"
