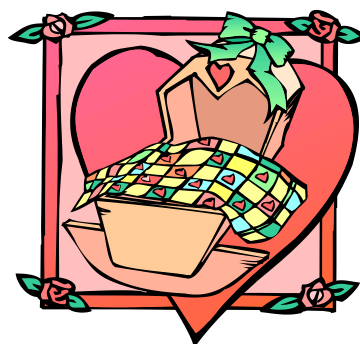
Share a Gift:
