

Despite a snowy day, many of our members made it to our November meeting and we were well rewarded with another amazing trunk show – this time by Joan Dorsay of Ottawa. Joan was a very delightful speaker with many interesting anecdotes about her quilt-making experiences and challenges, from the architectural inspirations of the Library of Parliament and other historic downtown Ottawa buildings for her quilt designs, to the time her husband spilled a cup of coffee on the white border of her almost-finished quilt. A very prolific hand-quilter, Joan was very interesting and inspirational.

Joan's Saturday workshop on back basting appliqué was attended by 8 people. Mary De Vries reports

"The workshop was very informative and we were a very productive group. I really liked the technique that Joan uses. It keeps your work in its exact position and is self-correcting. The design is traced on the back of the background fabric and worked from the front. The only drawback is that it is more time consuming but the end result is very effective." The attached picture is one corner of Mary's piece.

And Joan appreciated the warm welcome of our guild and would be open to returning for a beginner workshop. Stay tuned!



#### **Programme**

In addition to our speakers and presentations, our guild meetings include the following quilting activities:

- Show and Tell New this year: If you have brought something to show, please fill out a form on arrival to help our photographer keep track of the quilts and who showed them. We continue to need the perimeter of your quilt (in inches) for our participation in Quilt Canada's Walk to Brock guild challenge where the goal is to stitch from Mile Zero in Victoria to Brock University in St. Catharines, the home of Quilt Canada 2014. In November we added another 2,146 inches to bring our total to 9,187 inches
- **Block of the Month** The Chimney Sweep album block is due at the December meeting. Please use a white background for this block. Refer to the web site for <u>instructions and a photo of</u> this block.
- **Fat Quarter Exchange** NEW Bring 1 or 2 fat quarters to the meeting to exchange. Fat quarters should be good quality quilt shop fabric cotton prints or batiks. Batiks will be exchanged for batiks and cotton prints for cotton prints. Once members have made their exchanges, remaining fat quarters may be purchased (after the break) Batik \$2.50, Cotton print: \$2.00
- **Twisted Tinners** Sign up is now closed for this year and the participants are busy making blocks and exchanging the tins at our guild meetings.

**Library** - Our meetings also feature books and magazines which can be signed out from our extensive library collection to read and enjoy, and a "guess the number of pages" in the new book contest with the prize being first to sign out the new book.
