Charity Projects

Our guild is very involved in supporting local charities.

Preemie Quilts - Last year our members made and donated about 150 "preemie" quilts which were donated to the Rich Little Special Care Unit at the Ottawa Hospital (Civic Campus) for distribution to premature newborns. Families are typically surprised and very touched by this unexpected generosity. Refer to our web site for more information about making these adorable 24 inch square quilts.

Other Quilts – Many of the quilts that we pieced at our "jelly roll race" night have been completed and distributed. Five quilts have been sent to High River Alberta for flood victims, and eleven quilts were given to Phoenix Center, a local Renfrew County programme for teens between the ages 12 and 18 years who need special attention. There are several additional quilts which will be kept at the guild, made, and ready to give when needed.
