## BLOCK OF THE MONTH May 2015 "Chop Suey"

### Materials Required

White Fabric

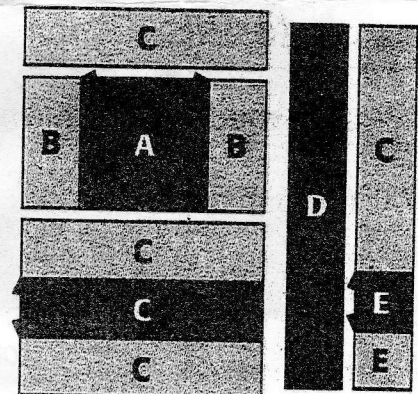
Batik any colour

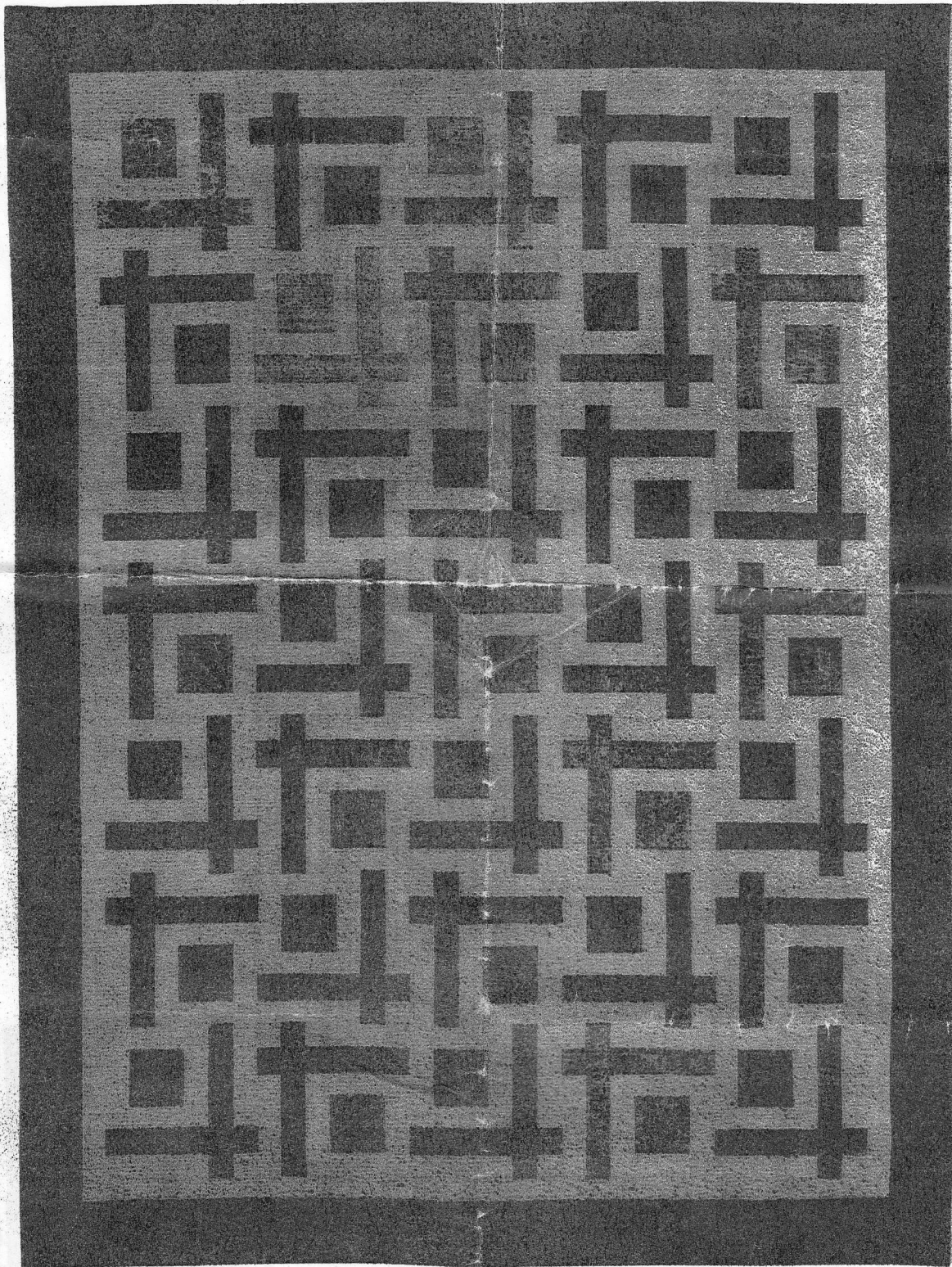
### Cutting Instructions for Block

- 1 – 5" (A) square batik
- 1 – 2 ½" x 9" (C) batik
- 1 – 2 ½" x 13" (D) batik
- 1 - 2 ½" x 2 ½" (E) square batik
- 2 - 2 ½" x 5" (B) white
- 3 - 2 ½" x 9" (C) white
- 1 - 2 ½" x 2 ½" (E) square white

### Block Assembly

1. Sew one 2 ½" x 5" rectangle (B) white to sides of 5" batik (A) square.
2. Sew one 2 ½" x 9" rectangle (C) white to sides of 2 ½" x 9" rectangle (C) batik .
3. Sew the two (E) 2 ½" squares batik & white together.
4. Then sew the 2 ½" x 9" rectangle (C) white to the 2 ½" square (E) batik .
5. Then sew the 2 ½" x 13" rectangle (D) batik to the unit made with the 2 ½" x 9" white and the 2 ½" batik and white squares.
6. SEE DIAGRAM FOR LAYOUT OF THE BLOCK.
7. Press all seams to the dark fabric.
