Month 1

Slice n' Dice Four Patch

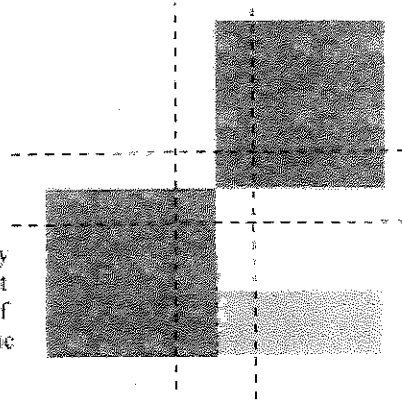
*makes one block (8" finished)

2 light squares @ 5" each

2 dark squares @ 5" each

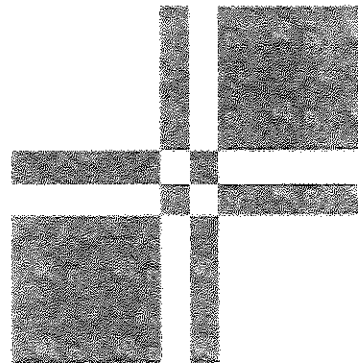
Assemble these squares into a Four Patch. Press.

Cutting: You will make 4 cuts in total (without moving any of the pieces). Measure $1\frac{1}{2}$ " from your center seam and cut – then make another vertical cut $1\frac{1}{2}$ " from the other side of the seam. Repeat these cuts horizontally, each $1\frac{1}{2}$ " from the seam.



*these cuts are shown as dotted lines in the example Four Patch.

Move the 4 "sashing" strips; Swap the top piece with the right, and the bottom with the left. Reassemble your block and press.



Bonus: If you like these blocks, try making cuts of different widths from your seams! You can quickly assemble a quilt with many unique blocks this way.
