## BLOCK OF THE MONTH October 2015

### POLKA DOT BLOCK

#### Materials Required

White Fabric (preferably white dot)

4 Coloured polka dot fabric

#### Cutting Instructions for Block

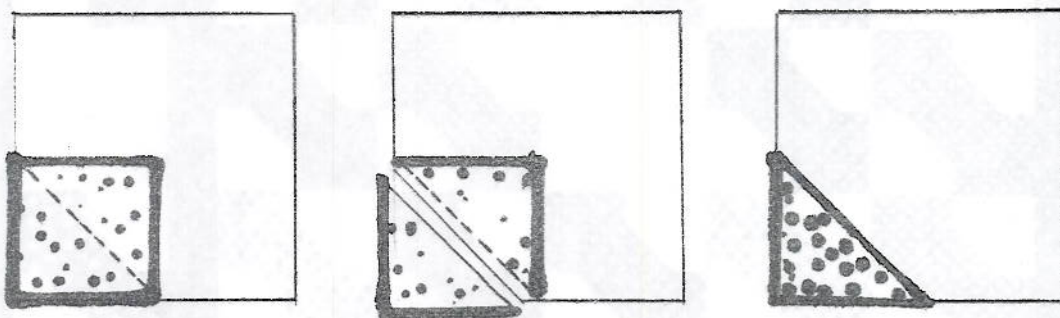
8 – white 3" squares

2 – 3" squares of each of the 4 colours

2 – 2" squares of each of the 4 colours

#### Block Assembly using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams

Draw diagonal line on each of the 2" dot squares. Place 2" square on corner of white 3" square. Stitch on marked line; trim and press seams open. Make 2 of each colour.

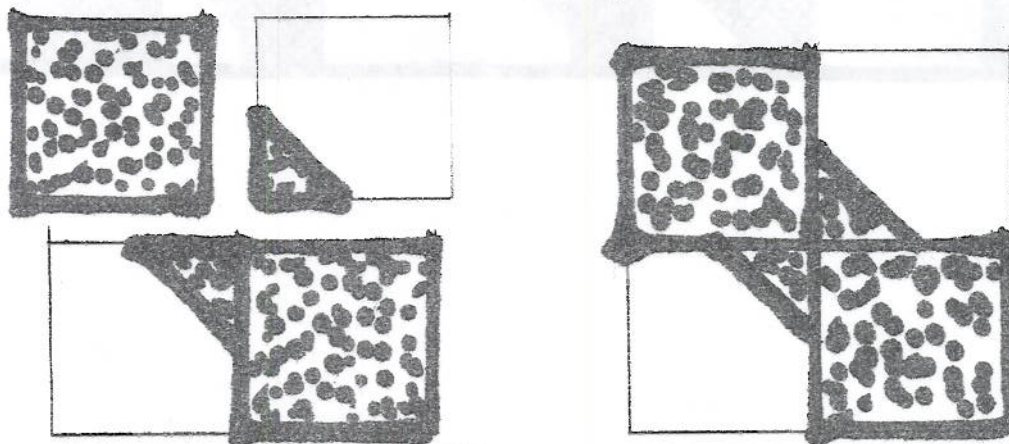


Then sew blocks together with like colours for each block as follows:

Polka Dot 3" square with white/polka dot 3" square

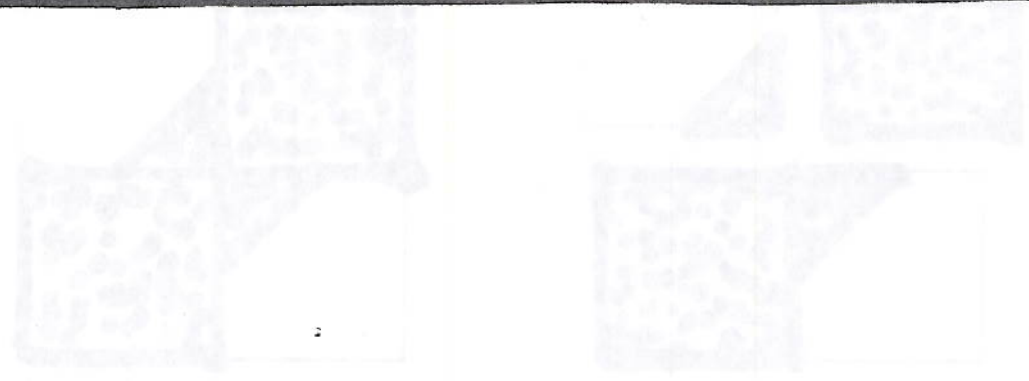
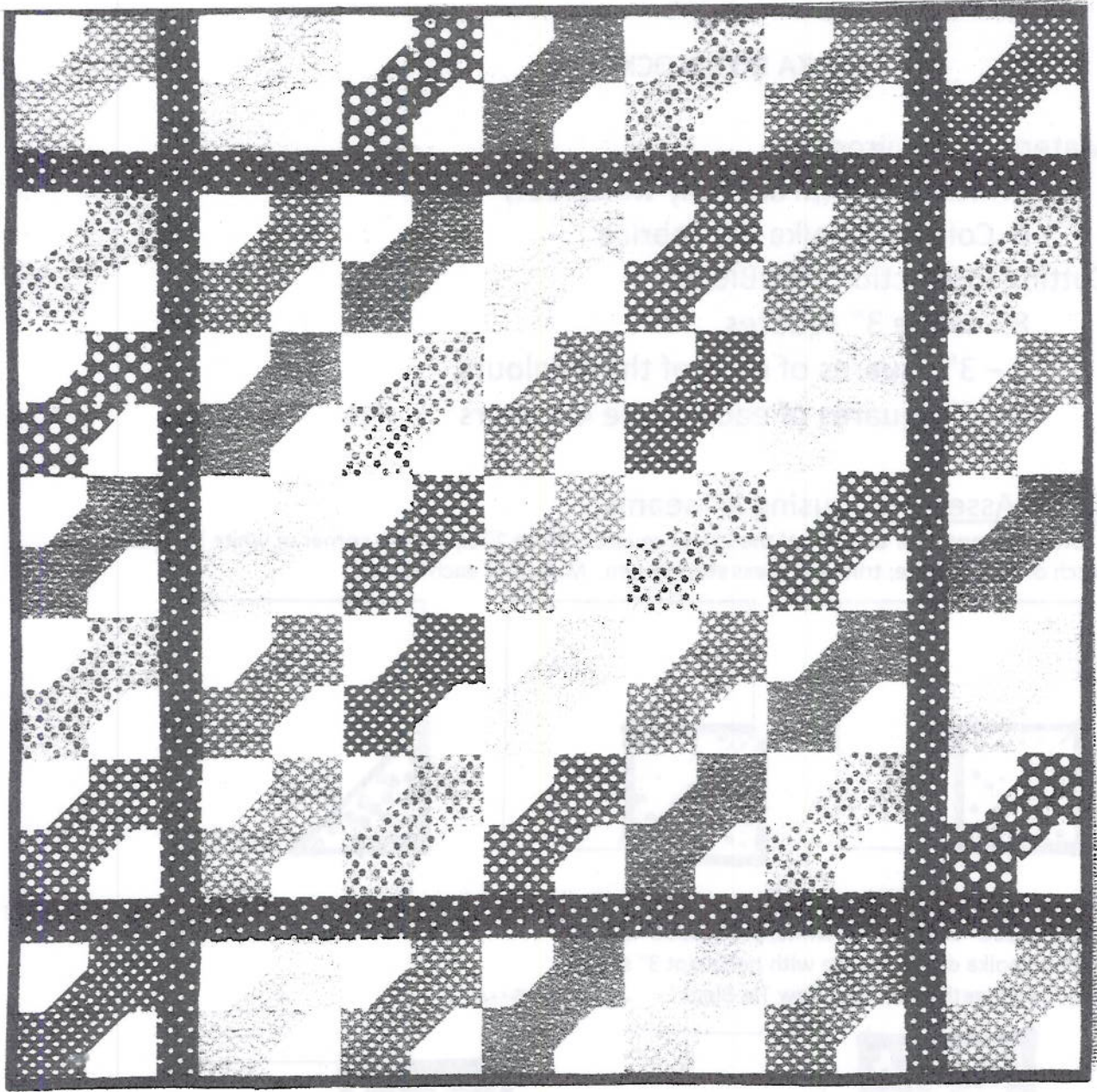
White/polka dot 3" square with polka dot 3" square

Sew rows together to make Bow Tie Block -  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square



Sew together 4 -  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " blocks to make a  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " block.
