

ADQG October Block of the Month
Falling Maple Leaves Table Runner
Blocks due November 23, 2016

Supplies needed to make one block:

- Small strips or scraps of 1 ½" squares of similar shades off one fall colour of your choice (i.e.: orange).
- A 12 ½" cream coloured background block.
- Pin any extra bits of scraps left from your piecing block to share with the winner of the blocks to make an interesting border or filler blocks.

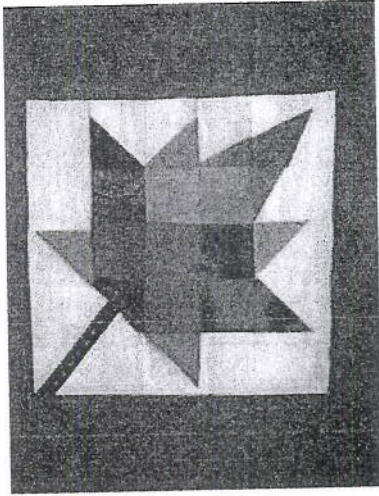
Instructions:

1. To piece the maple leaf applique material: choose from you scraps a fall colour you have a lot of. Take various strips or blocks of this colour (i.e.: Gold), and sew them together to make 1" squares strips. Sew about 8 strips to create a block large enough to cut your maple leaf template(s) from.
2. Then cut the shape of a maple leaf out of the pieced block. Note you can applique as many maple leaves of all sizes as you like on the block. Be creative and we can make each block a little different.
3. Machine Applique this colourful maple leaf or leaves onto the cream coloured background block.
