DISAPPEARING PINWHEEL

The finished block is 10 1/4 inch square and it is characterized as a two minute block! Just what we need a quick and easy block for quilter's therapy! See the hyperlink above for the full tutorial by Teresa. There are also 11 variations of this block, I chose block 5.

Materials required:

- Two 9 3/8 inch squares in contrasting fabrics. Hopefully you can use up your scraps on this project.
- <u>Colour theme:</u> Any spring coordinating colours. One fabric floral and the other a co-oridinating fabric.

Instructions as per illustrations diagrams on the next page.

- 1. Take two 9 3/8 inch blocks in contrasting fabrics and sew 1/4 inch all around the outside of the block.
- 2. Then with your rotary cutter slice the square in half once way, and without moving the block, slice it the other way as per the diagram.
- 3. Sew the blocks together into one large pinwheel as per diagram three.
- 4. Now slice the block into three 4" strips horizontally, and without moving the block slice it into three 4" strips vertically, as per diagram 4. You will now have 9 blocks.
- 5. Rearrange the blocks and sew them into the disappearing pinwheel, as per diagram 5.
