

#### Cutting:Block 1

5-1 1/2" x1 1/2" squares

Print of your choice-think tea cup Cup top: 1-4 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle Saucer: 1-1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle Co-ordinating print of your choice Cup bottom: 1-2 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle Handle: 3-1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles Steam-medium grey Cream Background



Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2-2½" Cup Background squares. Layer 1-2½" Cup Background square, right sides together, on each end of the1-8½" x 2½" Cup bottom as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.












Assemble the Cup as shown. Press in the directions of the arrows.






## Large Handles

(A) Join 1-1½" x 3½" Handle and 1-1½" x 3½" Cup Background.




- (B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2-1½" Cup Background squares.
- (C) Layer 1-1½" Cup Background square, right sides together, on 1-1½" x 2½" Handle rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.

Repeat as shown on a second 1-11/2" x 21/2" Handle rectangle.




(D) Join the units as shown and add Cup Background pieces to assemble the Handle.




### Small Handles

(A) Join 1-1½" x 2½" Handle and 1-1½" x 2½" Cup Background.




- (B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2-1½" Cup Background squares.
- (C) Layer 1-1½" Cup Background square, right sides together, on 1-1½" x 2½" Handle rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.

Repeat as shown on a second 1-11/2" x 21/2" Handle rectangle,



(D) Join the units as shown and add the Cup Background rectangle to assemble the Handle.












- Pans

### Saucer

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2-1½" Cup Background squares. Layer 1-1½" Cup Background square, right sides together, on each end of 1-8½" x 1½" Saucer rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.





## Steam for Blocks 1


- (A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 5-1½" Steam squares.
- (B) Layer 1-1½" Steam square, right sides together, on 1-2½" Cup Background square as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle. Repeat as shown on the same Cup Background square. Repeat to make 2 units.



(C) Layer 1-1½" Steam square, right sides together, on 1-2½" x 3½" Cup Background rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.



(D) Join the units as shown to make the Steam. Sew 1-4½" x 7½" Cup Background rectangle to each side of the Steam.

# Stitching the Steam

Note: Enlarge the steam pattern 200%.

Trace the pattern after enlarging, using a removable marker.

Use 3 strands of grey floss and the running stitch.
