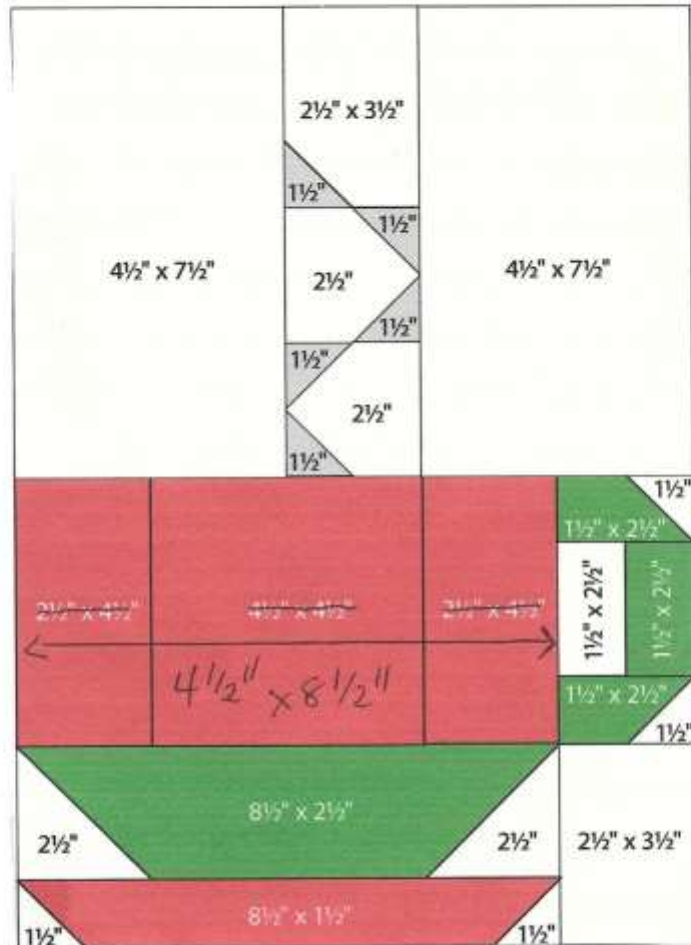


ADQG March 2017 Block of the Month, Tea Time

Cutting: Block 1

Print of your choice-think tea cup

Cup top: 1-4 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle

Saucer: 1-1 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle

Co-ordinating print of your choice

Cup bottom: 1-2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle

Handle: 3-1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

Steam-medium grey

5-1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares

Cream Background

4-1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares

1-1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

4-2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

2-2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

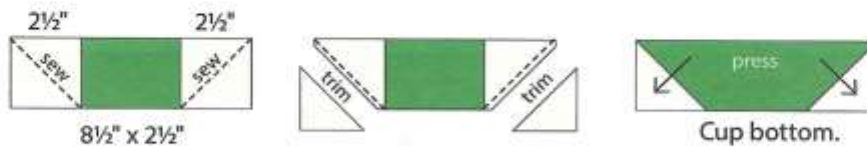
2-4 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangle

- 1 Make the Small Handle (page 23).
 Make the Saucer (page 24).
 Make the Steam (page 25).

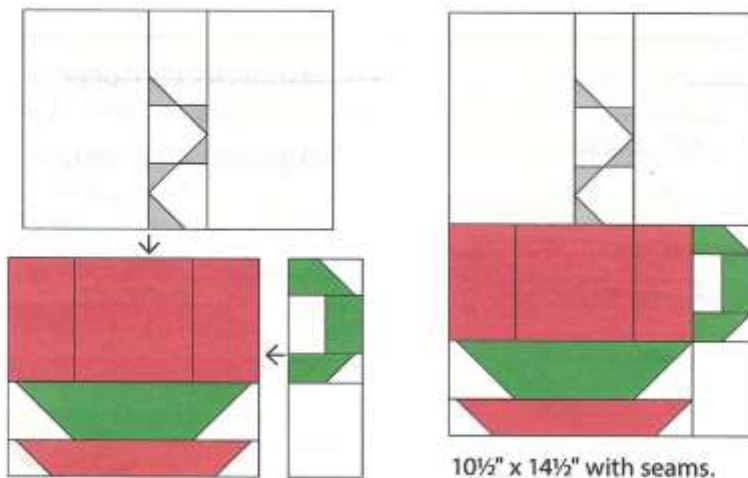
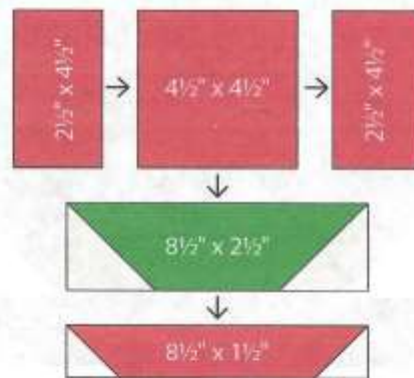

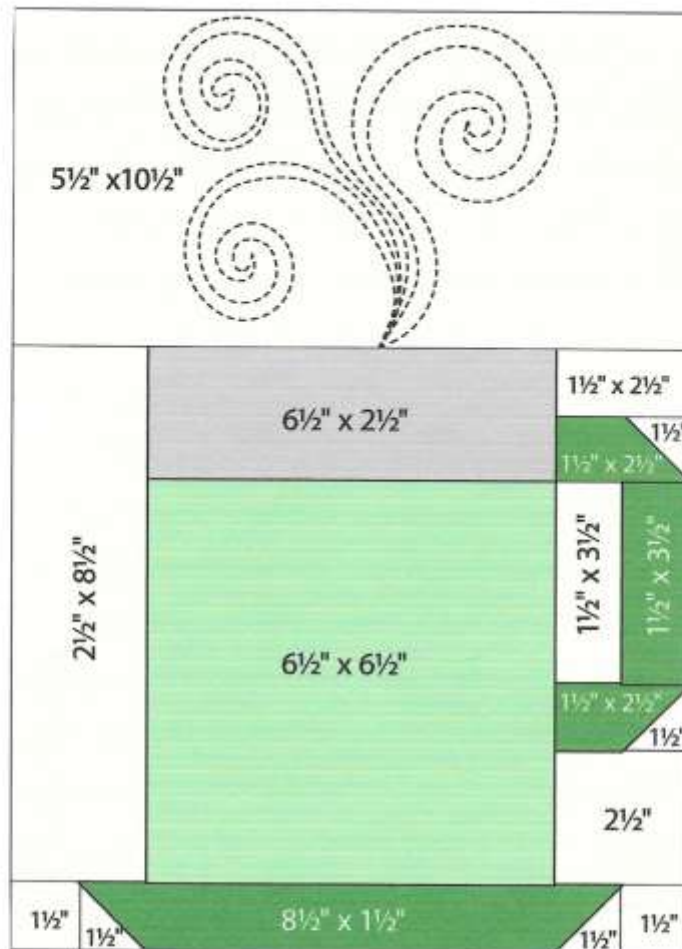


- 2 Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2-2½" Cup Background squares. Layer 1-2½" Cup Background square, right sides together, on each end of the 1-8½" x 2½" Cup bottom as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.



- 3 Assemble the Cup as shown. Press in the directions of the arrows.





Cutting: Block 2

Print of your choice—think coffee mug

Cup bottom: 1-6 1/2" x 6 1/2" square

Co-ordinating print of your choice

Cup rim: 1-6 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

2nd Co-ordinating fabric

Handle: 2-1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangles

1-1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle

Saucer: 1-1 1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangle

Cream Background

6-1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares

1-1 1/2" x 2 1/2" rectangle

1-2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares

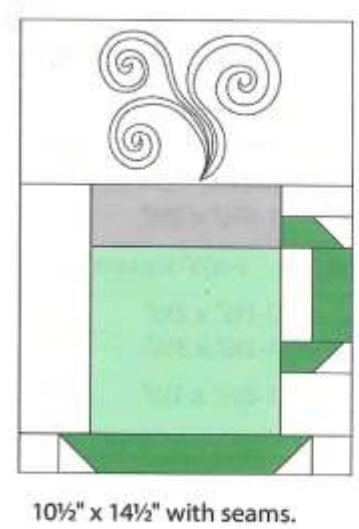
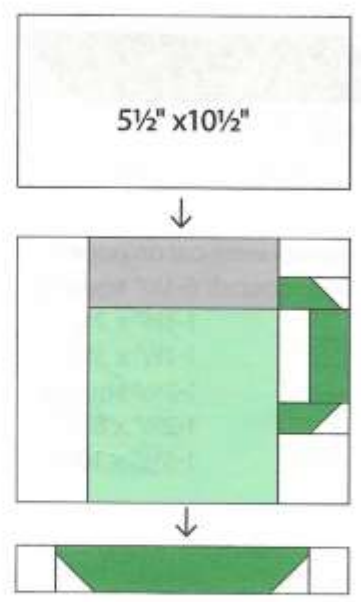
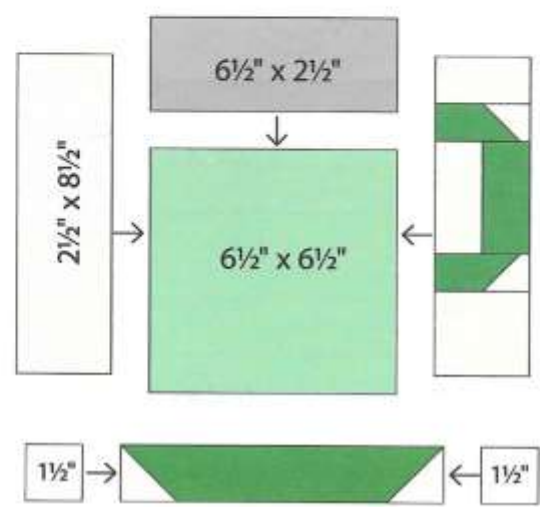
1-2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles

1-5 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangle

1-1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangle

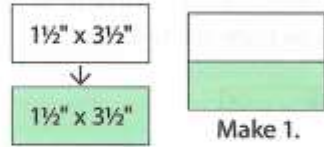
- 1 Make the Large Handle (page 23).
- 2 Make the Saucer (page 24).
- 3 Assemble the Cup as shown. Press in the directions of the arrows. Add the steam (page 26).

Large Handles

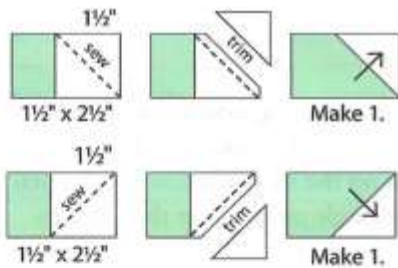
(A) Join 1-1/2" x 3/2" Handle and 1-1/2" x 3/2" Cup Background.



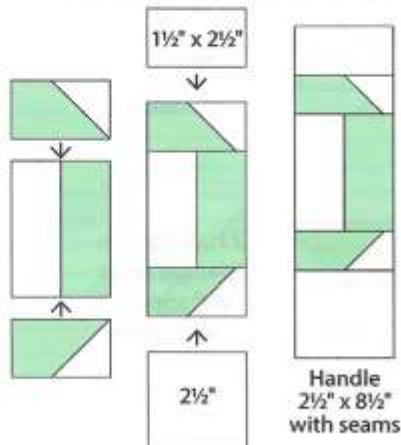
(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2-1/2" Cup Background squares.

(C) Layer 1-1/2" Cup Background square, right sides together, on 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Handle rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.

Repeat as shown on a second 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Handle rectangle.

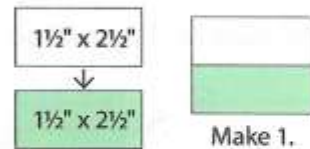


(D) Join the units as shown and add Cup Background pieces to assemble the Handle.



Small Handles

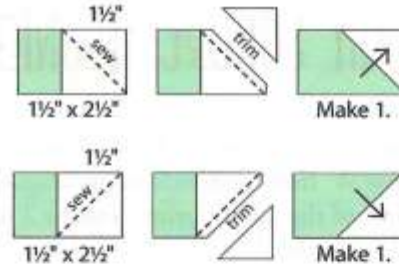
(A) Join 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Handle and 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Cup Background.



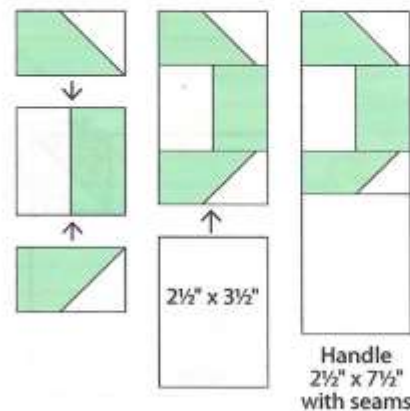
(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2-1/2" Cup Background squares.

(C) Layer 1-1/2" Cup Background square, right sides together, on 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Handle rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.

Repeat as shown on a second 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Handle rectangle.



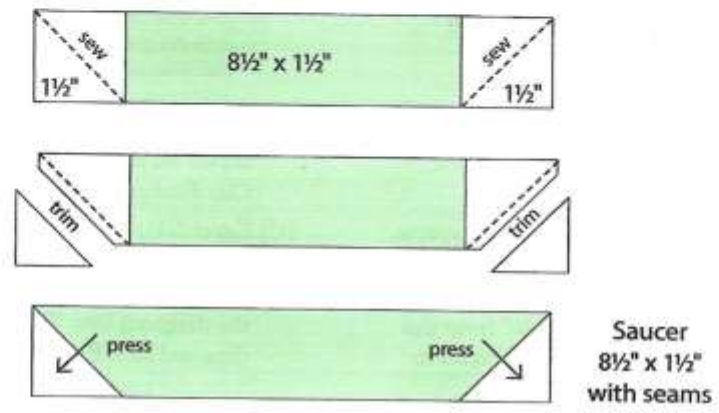
(D) Join the units as shown and add the Cup Background rectangle to assemble the Handle.



c. base

Saucer

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2-1½" Cup Background squares. Layer 1-1½" Cup Background square, right sides together, on each end of 1-8½" x 1½" Saucer rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.

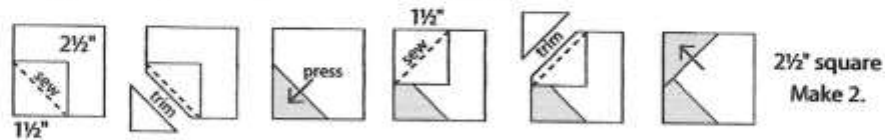

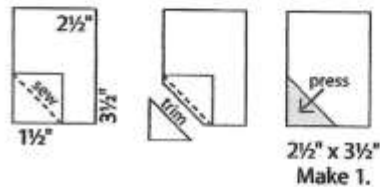
Steam for Blocks 1

(A) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Steam squares.

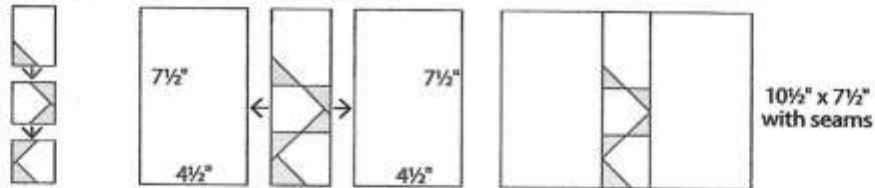
(B) Layer $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Steam square, right sides together, on $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Cup Background square as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle. Repeat as shown on the same Cup Background square. Repeat to make 2 units.



(C) Layer $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Steam square, right sides together, on $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Cup Background rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle.

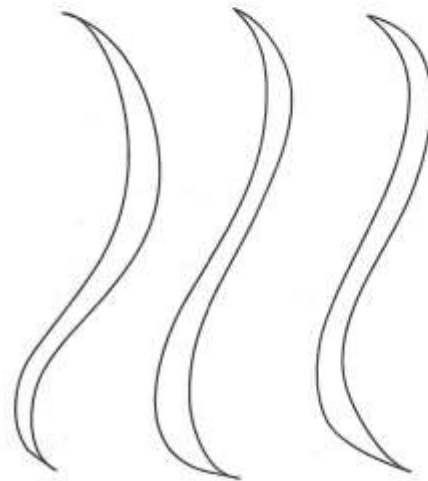
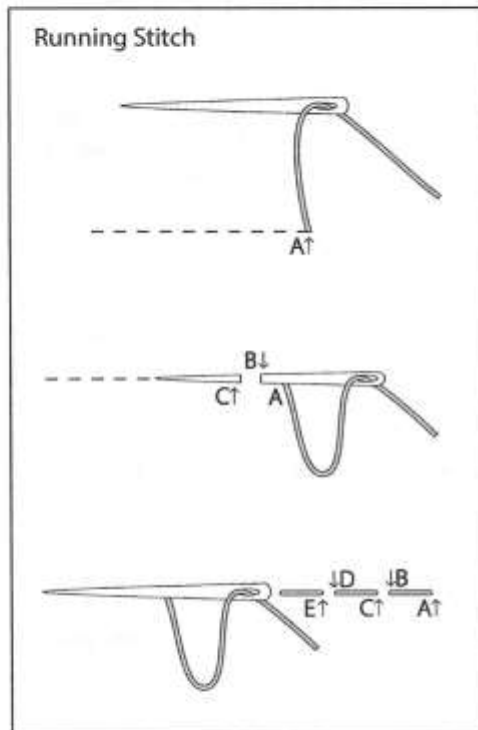


(D) Join the units as shown to make the Steam. Sew $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Cup Background rectangle to each side of the Steam.

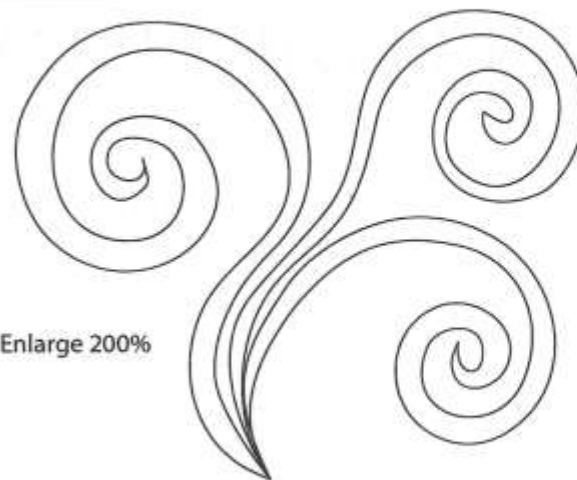


Stitching the Steam

Note: Enlarge the steam pattern 200%.
Trace the pattern after enlarging, using a removable marker.
Use 3 strands of grey floss and the running stitch.
