We are almost to the end of our Mystery quilt.....we are going to make a few pieced borders for around the blocks...

Applique border. Add to your log cabin block a piece of background fabric $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ to the left of the block and $5 \frac{1 / 2 \prime}{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2$ to the top. Pick one of the appliques provided or create your own to apply to these strips.

Checkerboard border:
Chose a light fabric and cut a strip $23 / 4$ " $\times 23^{\prime \prime}$. Select 4 darker fabrics and cut a strip $23 / 4$ "x $51 / 2$ "each
Sew the shorter strips into the large strip and press to the darer fabric. Cut each into segments of $23 / 4$ " Reassemble these units into two checkerboard strips. They should now measure 5" x 9 12 ".
