

Block of the Month...Mystery Quilt

The Big Reveal!

This year each pattern provided in the block of the month was part of a mystery quilt. Today we will reveal the layout to create a wall hanging. With each mystery there are always surprises. To be honest, I was surprised how much I disliked the look of the wall hanging when I laid out all the blocks. I found that the blocks just jumbled into one big unattractive mess. I think a more scrappy background fabric would have been better....but it was a mystery, so you don't know that until the end...right? As the saying goes "My Quilt, My rules", I changed the look. I completed my wall hanging using a 1" stashing between each section. For me, it made the blocks flow better. Below is a suggestion of how you may put the blocks together. Please note that in our mystery quilt, block R...known to us as the, cup and saucer block, is surrounded with pinwheels, not the blocks shown in the diagram.

I look forward to seeing your completed wall hangings in the fall. Remember...your quilt, your rules, so be creative.
