



Cutting strips for Eight Point Star



Place the ruler on the 45° line to get the 45° angle.

Place the ruler on the angle cut and measure 2 ³/₄" from the angle



Cutting 45-degree diamonds from strips

1. Square your fabric and cut a strip, in this case $2\frac{3}{4}$ " .
2. Turn the strip horizontally on your cutting mat and square the end.
3. Place the ruler on the strip, aligning the 45° line on your ruler along the horizontal edge of your strip. ...
4. Cut along the ruler edge from the bottom of the strip to the top.
5. Now line up the ruler with the 45° line that you have cut, and measure $2\frac{3}{4}$ " from the cutting line. You will have a diamond that is $2\frac{3}{4}$ " wide from both sides.

It works with any size, as long as you cut the original strip and the measurement from the angled cut the same size.
