

3. Arrange four HSTs with one white $2 \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " strip and one background 2×5 " strip, as shown in Fig. 3. Join as in the previous step, making sure to join the longer strip to the right hand side to complete one Unit B. Make 4 Unit B.

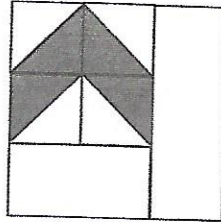

4. Arrange four Unit A and four Unit B with one 5 in. white square as shown in Fig. 4. Sew the units into rows, and then sew the rows together to create the block.

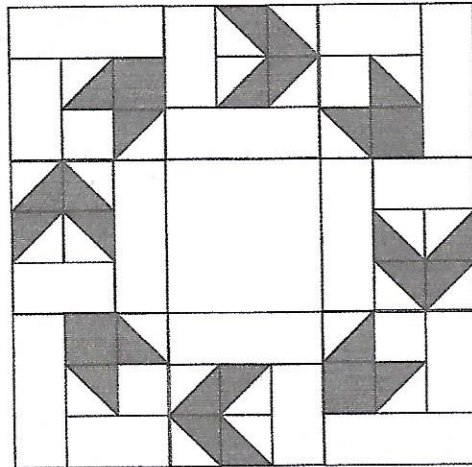
