Instructions for Completion of Stained Glass Blocks of the Month

- Print Layout and Reversed Patterns from Guild Website;
- 2. Cut your background fabric at least 9½ " X 12" to allow for trimming when the block is complete;
- 3. Draw an 8" X 10½" outline on the background fabric for placement of the pattern pieces and an 8½" X 11" outline for the quarter inch seam allowance. Use a removable form of marking so the lines will not be visible when the block has been laid out;
- 4. Trace all pattern pieces from the Reversed template onto your fusible web, leaving some space between the pieces. **NOTE**: include the quarter inch seam allowance on all pieces that will be placed on the edge of the block. Number all pieces for ease of placement;
- 5. Cut apart the traced pieces, leaving some extra fusible web around the traced lines;
- 6. Press fusible web pieces to the wrong side of your fabric pieces;
- 7. Cut fabric pieces along lines on fusible web. Do not remove paper from fusible web;
- 8. Using the layout template, and a light box/table if you have one, place the pattern pieces inside the 8" X 10½" box drawn on the background fabric until you are satisfied with your placement. The outside pieces will go to the seam allowance line.
- 9. Press all pieces on to the background fabric;
- 10. Sew all pieces with your choice of stitching (straight stitch close to the edges; blanket stitch; small zigzag). **NOTE**: if you use invisible thread the stitches will not be visible and you won't have to change your thread colour for each colour in the block, but the choice is yours.
- 11. Trim block to 8½" 11".
