# BCock of the Month - November 2017 Cross-Cut BCock 

## Cutting

Pattern Piece

Fabric Color

Cut 1 4" x 4" Light Blue
Cut 2 2.5" x 4" Dark Blue
Cut 2 2.5" x 8" Dark Blue
Cut 2 1.75" $\times 7$ " White
Cut 1.75 " $\times 14$ " White

## Piecing

1) Sew the $2.5^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 4^{\prime \prime}$ dark blue strips to opposite sides of the $4^{\prime \prime}$ light blue square. Sew the $2.5^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 8^{\prime \prime}$ dark blue strips to the top and bottom of the unit.
2) Cut that unit corner to corner, making 4 triangles.
3) Sew two of the triangle units to opposite edges of the $1.75^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ white strip. Match the cut edge to keep the unit aligned. Repeat with other triangles \& white strip.
4) Sew the two units to the $1.75^{\prime \prime} \times 14^{\prime \prime}$ strip. Match the centers to keep the two sides aligned.
5) Trim block to $8.5^{\prime \prime}$ square. You're done!
