# Scrappy Susamanah oult Block

## cutting

$8-2.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares in scrappy fabrics
$4-2.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares in whites
$2-3.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares in scrappy fabrics
$2-3.5^{\prime \prime}$ squares in whites

## Instructions

1. On the two $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ white squares, draw a diagonal line or fold in half and finger press.

2. Place each $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ white square right sides together with a $3.5^{\prime \prime}$ scrappy squares. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the line on both sides of the drawn line.

3. Cut along the drawn line to make two half square triangles (HST).

Trim to be $2.5^{\prime \prime}$ square. Open and press seams away from the white or open.
4. Layout squares as shown below and sew together. Block should measure 8.5".
