

Scrappy Susannah Quilt Block

Pattern by Andy Knowlton

Cutting

- 8 – 2.5" squares in scrappy fabrics
- 4 – 2.5" squares in whites
- 2 – 3.5" squares in scrappy fabrics
- 2 – 3.5" squares in whites

Instructions

1. On the two 3.5" white squares, draw a diagonal line or fold in half and finger press.
2. Place each 3.5" white square right sides together with a 3.5" scrappy squares. Sew 1/4" away from the line on both sides of the drawn line.



3. Cut along the drawn line to make two half square triangles (HST). Trim to be 2.5" square. Open and press seams away from the white or open.
4. Layout squares as shown below and sew together. Block should measure 8.5".
