## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From white or silver fabric:
(1) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 12$ "
(4) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$
(2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ "
(4) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(4) 1 " $\times 4$ "
(4) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(4) 1 " x $2^{\prime \prime}$

From the navy or black fabric:
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ 1/2"
(4) 2 " x 4 "
(4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ 1/2"
(4) 2 " squares

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Take a navy 2 " square and a white 1 " $\times 2$ " strip of fabric. Sew the white strip to the right hand side of the square and press seams toward the dark fabric unless stated otherwise.
2. Add a white $1^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top of the block. Sew and press.
3. Add a navy 2 " $\times 2$ 1/2" piece to the right hand side of the block. Sew and press.
4. Add a navy $2 " \times 4$ " piece to the top of the block. Sew and press.
5. Add a white 1 " $\times 4$ " strip of fabric to the right side of the block. Sew and press.
6. Add a white $1^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top of the block. Sew and press.
7. Add a navy 2 " $\times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece to the right hand side of the block. Sew and press.
8. Add a navy $2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ " strip to the top of the block. Sew and press.
9. Make 4 quadrants following the instructions above. Each quadrant should measure 6 " square.
10. Cut one of the quadrants in half on the diagonal once. Insert a white 1 " $\times 10$ " piece of fabric.
11. Sew the 3 pieces together. Press seams toward the white.
12. Trim excess white fabric. Once again, the quadrant should measure 6 " square. Repeat the previous 3 steps for the 3 remaining block quadrants.
13. Take two quadrants and one white 1 " $\times 6$ " strip of fabric and arrange as shown. Sew the 3 pieces together. Press seams toward the white. Make two.
14. Take the two block halves and the white 1 " $\times 12$ " strip of fabric. Arrange the piece as shown. Sew the pieces together and press well.
15. Your snowflake block is complete! It should measure 12" unfinished.
