Snowflake Block of the Month Due at the January 2019 meeting Free tutorial from Crazy Mom Quilts

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

From white or silver fabric:

(1) 1" x 12"	(4) 1" x 10"	(2) 1" x 6"
(4) 1" x 4 1/2"	(4) 1" x 4"	(4) 1" x 2 1/2"
(4) 1" x 2"		

From the navy or black fabric:

(4) 2" x 6" (4) 2" x 4 1/2" (4) 2" x 4" (4) 2" x 2 1/2" (4) 2" squares

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Take a navy 2" square and a white 1" x 2" strip of fabric. Sew the white strip to the right hand side of the square and press seams toward the dark fabric unless stated otherwise.
- 2. Add a white 1" x 2 1/2" strip to the top of the block. Sew and press.
- 3. Add a navy 2" x 2 1/2" piece to the right hand side of the block. Sew and press.
- 4. Add a navy 2" x 4" piece to the top of the block. Sew and press.
- 5. Add a white 1" x 4" strip of fabric to the right side of the block. Sew and press.
- 6. Add a white $1'' \times 4 1/2''$ strip to the top of the block. Sew and press.
- 7. Add a navy 2" x 4 1/2" piece to the right hand side of the block. Sew and press.
- 8. Add a navy 2" x 6" strip to the top of the block. Sew and press.
- Make 4 quadrants following the instructions above. Each quadrant should measure 6" square.
- 10. Cut one of the quadrants in half on the diagonal once. Insert a white 1" x 10" piece of fabric.
- 11. Sew the 3 pieces together. Press seams toward the white.
- 12. Trim excess white fabric. Once again, the quadrant should measure 6" square. Repeat the previous 3 steps for the 3 remaining block quadrants.
- 13. Take two quadrants and one white 1" x 6" strip of fabric and arrange as shown. Sew the 3 pieces together. Press seams toward the white. Make two.
- 14. Take the two block halves and the white 1" x 12" strip of fabric. Arrange the piece as shown. Sew the pieces together and press well.
- 15. Your snowflake block is complete! It should measure 12" unfinished.
