## Sunrise Clock Block Pattern from Fons & Porter's Modern Patchwork (Sept/Oct 2017)

From White fabric cut:

4 (5 inch) B squares


From each clock hand color cut:

 $2(2\frac{1}{2} \times 5)$  A rectangles for hands


## **ASSEMBLY**

## Make the clock hands


- 1. Make marks on 1 B square 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches in from the top left corner and 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches up from the bottom left corner. Connect the marks.
- 2. Place an A rectangle on the B square, aligning the cut edge of A with the marked line on the square. Sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam.



- 3. Press the A rectangle over the B square. Trim away the excess A rectangle using the B square corner as a guide. Trim the seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch. This is the hour hand.
- 4. Place the hour hand unit right side up with the hour hand in the upper right hand corner. Make marks 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches in from the top right corner and  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch up from the bottom right corner.
- 5. Line up the drawn line of the second A rectangle (the same color as the first) with the marks on the hour hand unit. Sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam.



- 6. Press and trim as before. Make 4, one in each color.
- 7. Arrange the 4 blocks as shown below and sew in a four patch and press.
