## Falling Leaves

$101 / 2 \prime$ " block unfinished

Read through directions before beginning and check your $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance before you sew

Fabric A -leaf : 4 or more different batik scraps in your choice of fall colours
Fabric B - background: 4 or more different batik scraps in light pastel shades to compliment your leaf fabrics

## Fabric A

Cut 8-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut 4-3" squares
Cut $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4$ " strip (for leaf stem)

Fabric B
Cut 8-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cut 5-3" squares

## Sewing Instructions

-For $1 / 2$ square triangles draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a $3^{\prime \prime}$ square of fabric $B$
-Right sides together layer it over a $3^{\prime \prime}$ piece of leaf fabric A

- Stitch a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of diagonal line (fig 1)
- Cut on drawn line and press seam to dark fabric -Repeat first four steps with 3 other pairs of fabric -Trim all 8 triangle squares to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Stem Square

-Cut in half diagonally your remaining 3 " square of fabric $B$ -Right sides together place the long side of one triangle on one side of the stem piece and sew with $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam (fig 2)
-Press towards dark


Fig 2 -Repeat steps for opposite side of stem
-Trim this unit to $21 / 2 \prime$ square - place 45 degree diagonal line on ruler down the centre of the stem for cutting placement

## Block Assembly

-Refer to Fig 3 for correct placement of squares, triangle squares and stem; sew together each row alternating pressing seams right to left then left to right
-Making sure to match seams, sew row 1 to row 2; then sew this unit to 3 ; continue to add row 4 and finally row 5 -Press seams in one direction

Admire your finished block - well done!
